



Provisional residence permit under temporary protection for Ukrainian displaced residents

On March 3rd 2022, the European Council adopted unanimously an implementing decision introducing temporary protection due to the mass influx of persons fleeing Ukraine as a consequence of the war.

These are the steps to follow to apply for this protection in the Pyrénées-Orientales county.


